

Australian Fresh Fruit Exports


Exchange Rates, drought, GFC, domestic market prices, FTA's, market access, competitors, DEMAND

Australian Blueberry Results

Export by state

Australian blueberry exports increased 93 per cent in 2019/20 to 384 tonnes valued at AU\$8.08 million. New South Wales and Queensland accounted for over 95 per cent of the national exports Tasmania had no recorded exports

Victoria lifted 124 per cent off a low base, and arguably may have exported some Tasmanian sourced fruit with a higher price point.





Australian Blueberry Results Export by state


Ninety-five per cent of exports were from New South Wales and Queensland, and most of the balance from Victoria. There were no recorded exports from Tasmania.








Australian Blueberry Exports by month 2019/20 vs last 2 years

Over last 12 months the leading 5 markets for Australian blueberries were Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia and Malaysia, accounting for 96% of all annual blueberry exports by volume.





Australian Blueberry Results 10-year trend

The 10 year moving annual total trend for blueberries with recorded price points highlights the variable growth with the 2019/20 season the highest in the decade edging ahead of 2016 record. Unit values increase likely a reflection of the exchange rate though softer pricing in 2019.

10-year trend by market

102 per cent growth in 1 year and 11 per cent growth over 5 years with growth in most markets Hong Kong, Singapore and Thailand appear to have steady gains over time Trade to Europe seems to have ground to a halt – influenced by Peru No major market access agreements to assist new market growth
