

Carrot Export Update

November 2021

National exports of carrots from January to November 2021 were **94111** tonnes worth A\$83.09. The result was 5 per cent below the same period last year (Table 1). The 12-month (MAT) to November was 105,057 tonnes and falling.



The United Arab Emirates, the largest export market with 27,622 tonnes, was no change to last year and Saudi Arabia 4 per cent down giving up of the gains of the previous year. Malaysia was 18 per cent higher to 15,395 tonnes while Singapore recorded a 4 per cent decline (Table 3). Other market had larger per centage falls.

share of season

On a month to month basis the November exports were 11,984 tonnes, compared to 10,068 tonnes last year (Figure 1.) Overall trend by month was well below the previous year in September and October.





MAT - Moving Annual Total

In 2020, 2.8 million tonnes of carrots were traded globally. Australia was the 6th largest exporter and accounted for 4.0 per cent share of the global trade, behind China, Netherlands, Belgium, Mexico and Spain.
