

Carrot Export Update



May 2022

National exports of carrots from January to May 2022 were 37,450 tonnes worth A\$36.33m. The result was 6 below last year for the same period (Table 1) and 4 per cent higher in value influenced by 10.6 per cent higher unit values. The Moving Annual Total (MAT) 100,666 tonnes and falling 1.0 per cent in the month indicating falling momentum.

The UAE remains the largest market with 11,353 tonnes recorded and 2 per cent lower than the same period a year ago although March to May results were 28 per cent lower. Other Middle east markets recorded negative growth rates and the Middle East overall was 4.1 per cent lower at 29,616 tonnes, accounting for 57 per cent of all exports. (Table 4)

Several Asian markets were weaker in the quarter notably Malaysia, the no.2 market, was 3 per cent lower. (Table 3)


Western Australia remains the largest export state accounting for 91 per cent of the national exports followed by Tasmania. Tasmanian exports were 51 per cent lower. On a month to month basis the May exports were 7,927 tonnes compared to 8,947 tonnes last year (Figure 1).
