

By May 2022, national exports of apples were **1,079** tonnes worth A\$2.67m. The volumes were 7 per cent above last year (Table 1). Unit values were 5 per cent lower to A\$2.53 / kg and has meant the overall value increased by 12 per cent for the period. The MAT (moving annual total) measured 2,734 tonnes and was 2 per cent lower than the previous month indicating a slowing of the earlier momentum.

PNG was the lead market with 260 tonnes, followed by Hong Kong and then China, Tasmania exported the total of 165 tonnes to China (Table 3). Hong Kong was 85 per cent higher at 209 tonnes, mostly exported in May.

Tasmania was the second largest export state for the period behind Victoria, accounting for 23 per cent of exports lifting 668 per cent to 252 tonnes due to China.
