

Monthly Export Update

December 2021

By December 2021, the first two months of the 2021/22 season national exports of cherries were **1,006** tonnes worth A\$19.81m. The volumes were 47 per cent below last year (Table 1). Unit values were 17 per cent higher to A\$19.68 and has meant the overall value decreased by 38 per cent for the period. The MAT (moving annual total) measured 3,812 tonnes and was 11 per cent lower than the previous month indicating a decline in momentum.

Vietnam was the lead market with 305 tonnes, though 11 per cent lower while China was 85 per cent lower (Table 3). Hong Kong, the largest market for 12 months of trade, was 24 per cent lower at 200 tonnes.

Tasmania was the largest export state for the 12 months, which was all last season at this stage and will not record any trade until late December.



On a month to month basis the December exports were 800 tonnes, compared to 1,289 tonnes last year or 38 per cent lower and prices were 21 per cent higher at A\$19.72 per kg (Figure 1).
