

Monthly Export Update

November 2021

EXPORTS

By November 2021, the first month of the 2021/22 season national exports of cherries were **211** tonnes worth A\$4.03m. The volumes were 66 per cent below last year (Table 1). Unit values were 6 per cent higher to A\$19.11 and has meant the overall value decreased by 63 per cent for the first month of the season.

Vietnam was the lead market, though 48 per cent lower while China was 83 per cent lower (Table 3). The season was rain affected.

Tasmania was the largest export state for the 12 months, which was all last season at this stage and will not recird any trade until late December.

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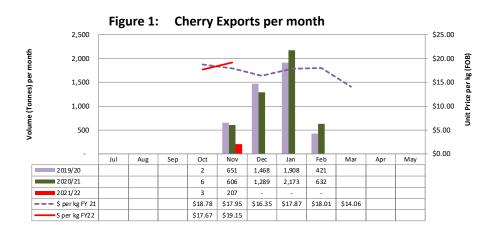

On a month to month basis the November exports were 207 tonnes, compared to 606 tonnes last year or 66 per cent lower and prices were 7 per cent higher at A\$19.15 per kg (Figure 1).
