

Monthly Export Update

February 2022

By February 2022, the 2021/22 season national exports of cherries were **3,897** tonnes worth A\$73.22m. The volumes were 17 per cent below last year (Table 1). Unit values were 7 per cent higher to A\$18.79 and has meant the overall value decreased by 11 per cent for the period. The MAT (moving annual total) also measured 3,897 tonnes and was 4 per cent lower than the previous month indicating a small decline in momentum.

Hong Kong was the lead market with 994 tonnes, though 15 per cent lower while China was 67 per cent lower (Table 3). Vietnam was 7 per cent higher at 810 tonnes.

Tasmania was the largest export state for the 12 months, accounting for 60.5 per cent of exports falling 2 per cent to 2,360 tonnes. Final adjustments may yet be made.



On a month to month basis the January exports were 2,466 tonnes, compared to 2,173 tonnes last year while February exports based on DAWE data were 460 tonnes compared to 632 tonnes last year (Figure 1).
