- Do not walk off the designated pathways into production areas; they're not ready to be picked yet
- Please don't bring your pet dog along on farm visits
- Let the grower know if you have visited any similar berry farms or orchards recently
- Park your vehicles in the designated parking area

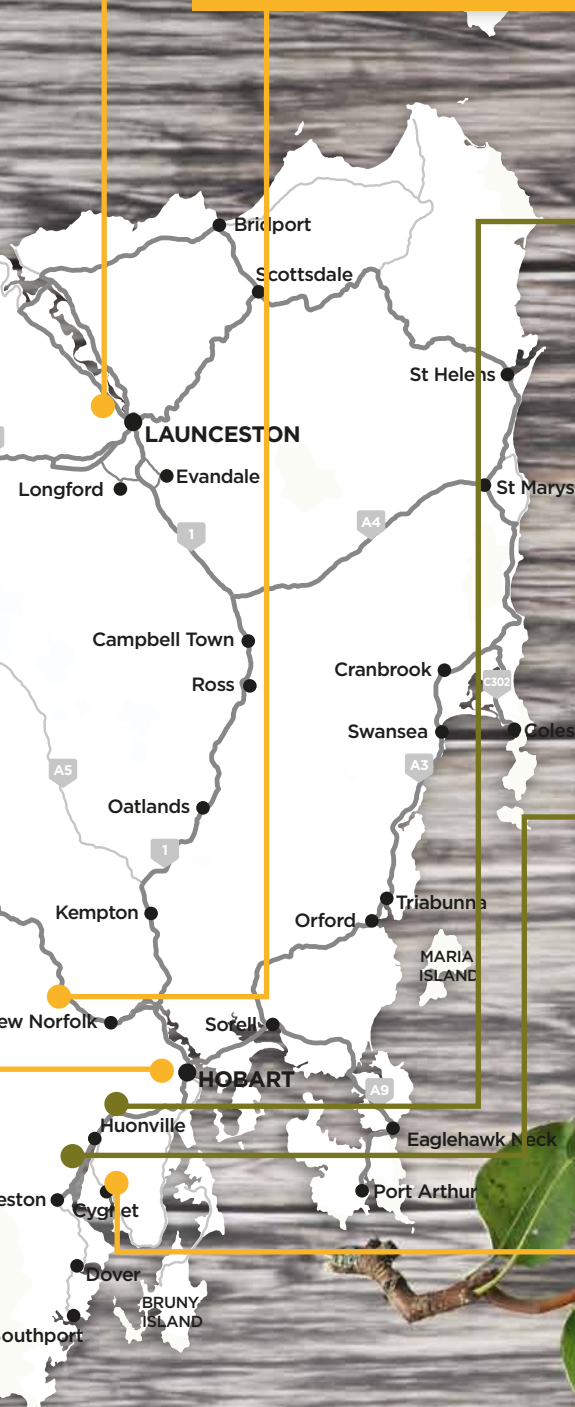

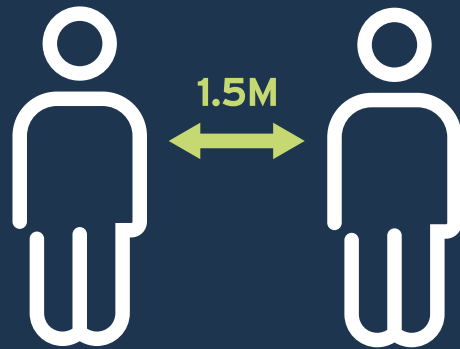

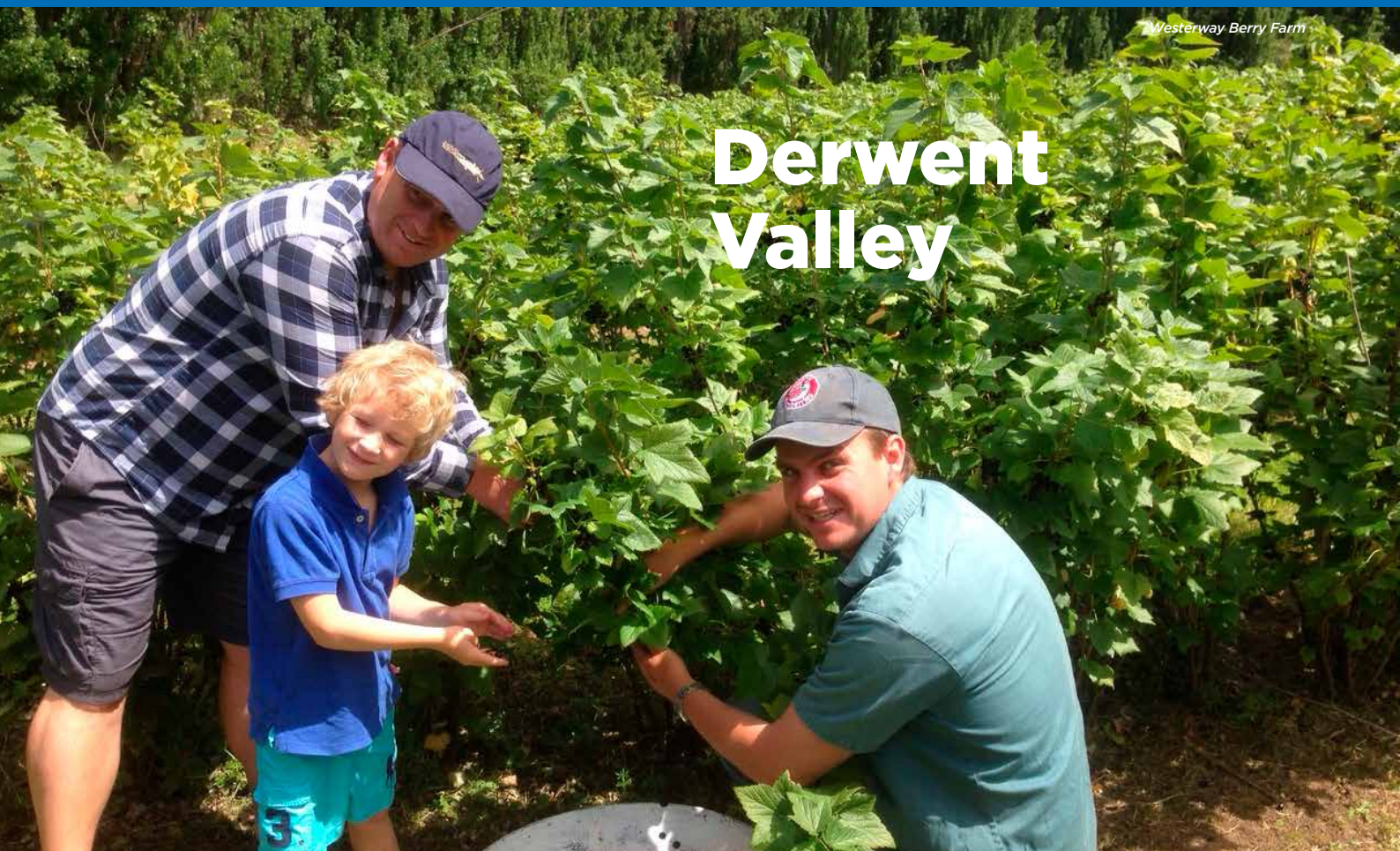
