Get to know the Biosecurity Basics

Be careful what you bring with you to Tasmania.

Tasmania has some of the world's most stringent biosecurity requirements, but we need your help to protect Tasmania from introduced pests, weeds and diseases. When you are returning home from a trip or visiting Tasmania, **CHECK YOUR BAGS** to ensure you are not carrying or importing any restricted or prohibited materials.

**COME
IN CLEAN**

Be sure to arrive in Tasmania with clean clothing, vehicles and equipment. Biosecurity threats including soil, weed seeds, disease agents and insect pests can have a negative impact on Tasmania's biosecurity, so be sure to thoroughly clean your clothes, vehicles and equipment **BEFORE** travelling to Tasmania so you can **COME IN CLEAN**.

Do not enter properties or private land without permission. Please resist the temptation to jump a fence to pose for a photo among the cherry trees or in an apple orchard - you could unintentionally introduce a pest, weed or disease to the property. Please respect the biosecurity protocols and plans of owners, operators and managers, and seek permission **BEFORE** entering.
