





Get to know the Biosecurity Basics

Be careful what you bring with you to Tasmania. Tasmania has some of the world's most stringent biosecurity requirements, but we need your help to protect Tasmania from introduced pests, weeds and diseases. When you are returning home from a trip or visiting Tasmania, CHECK YOUR BAGS to ensure you are not carrying or importing any restricted or prohibited materials.





COME IN CLEAN

Be sure to arrive in Tasmania with clean clothing, vehicles and equipment. Biosecurity threats including soil, weed seeds, disease agents and insect pests can have a negative impact on Tasmania's biosecurity, so be sure to thoroughly clean your clothes, vehicles and equipment BEFORE travelling to Tasmania so you can COME IN CLEAN.

Do not enter properties or private land without permission. Please resist the temptation to jump a fence to pose for a photo among the cherry trees or in an apple orchard - you could unintentionally introduce a pest, weed or disease to the property. Please respect the biosecurity protocols and plans of owners, operators and managers, and seek permission BEFORE entering.



STAY ON THE PATH



REPORTANYTHING UNUSUAL

See it. Secure it. Report it.

Keep an eye out for anything that could pose a biosecurity risk to Tasmania. If you **SEE** something unusual, for example fruit fly larvae in your fruit or vegetables, a plant disease, or an invasive pest or weednote the location and take a photo. **SECURE** the insect and **REPORT** it as soon as possible to **Biosecurity Tasmania** on **6165 3777**.
